

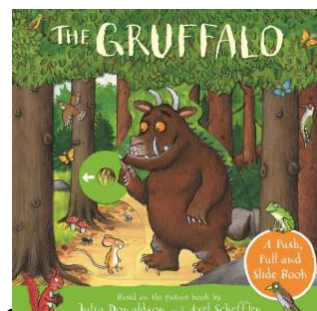
Curriculum Overview – Year 1

3rd November -19th December

Reading:

This half term, our core texts are Look Up and The Gruffalo. With the aid of these texts, your child will develop key curriculum skills, including:

- Sequencing words to make a complete sentence.
- Writing words with the suffix “ing” and using them in a sentence.
- Using the conjunction “and” to join two sentences together.



Writing (including spellings, grammar and punctuation):

Children will be given the opportunity to write for a range of purposes including posters to persuade, fact files to inform and rewriting a story to entertain. They will develop their use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

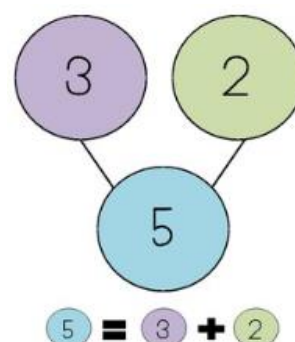
Maths

Comparing quantities - part whole relationships

- Comparing capacity, mass, height and length.
- Comparing amounts.
- Using the inequality and equals symbols to compare.
- Represent numbers using a part whole diagram.
- Solve problems using a part whole diagram.

Composition of numbers 1-5

- Partition numbers in different ways.
- Solve part whole diagrams.
- Find one more and one less than.
- Use a bar model to represent partitioning.



Recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes

- Copy, extend and describe patterns involving shapes.
- Compare, describe and sort 3D shapes.
- Spot 2D shapes within 3D shapes.

Science

Seasonal changes: Autumn and Winter

- Describing changes and weather in Autumn.
- Describing changes and weather in Winter.
- Observing what happens to day length in Winter.

Tempo

- Using voices and bodies expressively whilst exploring tempo.
- Perform a rhyme with slow and fast beats using voices and instruments.
